All seniors will be working on their Career Pathways during 4th period during the next few months to prepare them for career readiness standards.

9th, 10th, 11th grade

All 9th, 10th, 11th grade students have taken the second round of the CERT test, an ACT-like assessment to determine areas of strengths and weaknesses.

Results of the CERT will be used to place students with teachers in the areas they most need instruction for improving their skills during their 4th period class. This website is accessible by all students from any location using any browser.
