

MRC SBDM Meeting
Regular Session
April 12, 2016

Darwin Noble made the motion to call the meeting to order at 4:00 PM. Jamie Mullins-Smith seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor.

All members were present.

Marlene Hamilton made a motion to approve the reading of the last meeting minutes. Chris Banks seconded the motion with all members voting in favor.

Budget:

*Test remains the same for this year. K-PREP practice test books have been ordered for grades 3-6.

*End of the year trip for 4-6 grades will require \$1000 for travel expenses. Jamie Mullins-Smith voted in favor of giving the money for the trip. Mary Kay Caudill seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor.

*Grades K-3 will have activities for the end of the year. Cost would be minimal. Jamie Mullins-Smith made the motion to contribute to their activities. Chris Banks seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor.

*Individual Student Folders (data folders)-Folders need to be ordered. Jamie Mullins-Smith voted in favor of ordering the folders. Chris Banks seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor.

RTI:

Policy is in progress. All teachers are providing interventions and enrichments.

1st reading Student Placement Policy Update (see attachment):

Mr. Noble explained that this policy was only a beginning work. He will discuss with Mr. Royce Mayo (ER) and with state management about what is the best practice for doing this. The council will return to this policy next meeting.

30/60/90 Day Plan:

The plan has been updated and includes hiring 2 tutors. Cynthia Pelfrey for grades 1 and 2, Ella Cole for grades 2 and 3.

Quarterly Report:

Mr. Noble went over test data, student and teacher attendance, and other information. He stated that it appears MRC is moving in the right direction to reach Proficiency.

Library Report:

Mr. Hack Hudson discussed the library budget and what he purchased with the funds. He said that he tried to focus on what the teachers in the building needed and asked for the most. At this time, the library is up to date with books and materials. Therefore, he said he purchased periodicals for school use and placed money in technology to purchase programs such as MobyMax. He stated that he wanted to make sure that the library had materials that the teachers and students could use.

MAP Testing:

Third round of MAP testing for grades 3-6 will be April 18-22.
MAP testing for K-2 will be May 2-6.

K-PREP Testing:

K-PREP testing will begin on May 9th (18 days until testing window).
Proctors have been established for students with IEP's and will be certified teachers from grades K-2.

Vison and Mission Statement:

Staff is completing both the vision and mission statement. Both statements will be presented to SBDM for approval at the regular May meeting.

End of the Year 4-6 Trip/End of the Year Field Day K-3:

The annual end of the year field trip for grades 4-6 will be on May 4th. Grades K-3 will have a field day with planned activities at a later date. The date will be determined when testing has been completed.

Accelerated Reading Incentive Trip (Students with 50 or more AR points):

This trip will take place on April 26th (pending central office approval).

Manner's Banquet for 6th Grade:

The annual manner's banquet will be April 29th for 6th Grade. They will travel to London, Ky. for lunch at Golden Corral and fun time at Finley's Fun Park.

SBDM Parent and Teacher Elections:

Teacher nominations will be the 1st week of May (May2-6) and voting will take place Monday, May 9th.

Parent nominations will be May 9-13. Nominations can be turned into Jackie O'Neill.

Other concerns:

*PTO has purchased testing kickoff t-shirts for all students and faculty.

*May 5 will be the 6th grade Career Showcase led by Jason Fugate and Lisa Miller.

*May 9-13 the 6th graders can go after school to 21st Century at Sebastian Middle School to become familiar with the school and program.
