**Policy: Foreign Language Credit**

In order for a student at Breathitt County High School to meet the requirements for receiving a foreign language credit by participating in an abroad foreign language program, the following criteria must be met:

- The student must be immersed in the areas of formal education, structured cultural events, and host family daily living activities.
- The student and parent must present documentation to BHS SBDM council for approval. Formal documentation must be included such as a certificate from an accredited institution such as the ACTFL (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages). Other documentation may be required at the request of the SBDM council.
- To earn a credit, a minimum of 157 hours of immersion must be completed. A maximum of 2 credits shall be given to a student in one foreign language.
